Know all men by These Presents, That Dayton Durnn, (unmarried) of The City of Portland Multnomah County State of Oregon in consideration of the sum of Four hundred and fifty Dollars, to him in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, sell and convey unto Christopher D. Bruun of Portland Multnomah County, State of Oregon his heirs and assigns forever, the following described premises in Skamania County, state of Washington, to wit: All of Government Lots No. 1, also the Northeast Quarter of the Northwest Quarter (N.E. 4 of N.W. 4); also the North half of the Northeast Quarter (N. 2 of N.E. 4) all in Section Nineteen (19) in Township Two 22 North of Range Six (6) East of the Willamette Meridian containing One hundred, fifty eight and 55/100 acres.

All of said land having been acquired by the said Dayton Durnn by Homestead entry as evidenced by "Final Receiver's Receipt" No. 4114 issued June 28th 1898. and the said Dayton Durnn does hereby covenant to and with the said Christopher D. Bruun, his heirs and assigns that Dayton Durnn is the owner in fee simple of said premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, and that he will warrant and defend the title to the same against all lawful claims whatsoever.
