To Have and To Hold, the same unto the said The Duncan and Brewer Lumber Co., and to its successors and assigns forever.

And the said Joel Bate, the grantor above named, does thereby covenant with the said grantee, its successors and assigns, that at the date thereof he is well seized in fee simple of the premises above conveyed, and that he will and his heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons whomsoever.
