ORDINANCE NO. 29.

AN ORDINANCE VACATING THAT PORTION OF ROOSEVELT STREET LYING AND BEING BETWEEN BLOCKS 4 AND 5, IN JOHNSON'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF STEVENSON.

IN THE MATTER OF THE VACATING A PORTION OF ROOSEVELT STREET, LYING AND BEING BETWEEN BLOCKS 4 AND 5 OF JOHNSON'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF STEVENSON, WASHINGTON, IT APPEARING THAT A PETITION HAS BEEN DULY PRESENTED BY THE OWNERS OF THE ABUTTING PROPERTY, AND THAT HEARING OF THE SAME HAS BEEN HAD, AND THAT SAID HEARING HAS BEEN DULY ADVERTISED ACCORDING TO LAW AND THAT THE LAW HAS BEEN FULLY COMPLIED WITH IN ALL THINGS PERTAINING TO THE VACATION OF SAID PORTION OF ROOSEVELT STREET, LYING AND BEING BETWEEN BLOCKS 4 AND 5, IN JOHNSON'S ADDITION TO THE TOWN OF STEVENSON.
