## Assignment of Water Rights

This Indenture made this day by and between Underwood Soil Conservation District, hereinafter called the first party, and Public Utility District No. 1, of Skamania County, Washington, hereinafter called the second party, Witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, and other valuable considerations in hand paid by the second party to the first party, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the first party hereby SELLS, ASSIGNS, TRANSFERS AND CONVEYS to the second party all of the right, title and interest in and to 0.5 cubic feet of water per second of time from Moss Creek Springs, a tributary to the Little White Salmon River, granted to the first party by the State of Washington, dated August 16, 1943, as recorded in Vol. 15, page 3691 of Permits in the Office of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of the State of Washington.
