

Certificate of Sale. J. D. Peters vs. Dayton Dunn.

I, George Rabenau, Sheriff of the County of Skamania in the State of Washington, do hereby certify that pursuant to a judgment of foreclosure and order of sale entered in the Superior Court of said County and State on the 2nd day of May A. D. 1900 in an action wherein J. D. Peters is Plaintiff and Dayton Dunn Defendant. Said order of sale having been duly certified and together with a writ of execution issued therewith to me as such Sheriff directed and delivered, commanding me to sell according to law all or so much as may be necessary of the real property described in said order to satisfy said judgment amounting to the sum of Three Hundred Fifty Two and $\frac{17}{100}$ (\$352 $\frac{17}{100}$) Dollars, inclusive of interest, costs of suit and increased costs. I gave due and legal notice of said sale and on the 30th day of June A. D. 1900 at - o'clock 3.40 P. M., at the front door of the Court House in Stevenson in said County of Skamania, I duly sold said real property at public auction to the highest bidder, to-wit: to J. H. Hawley Co. a corporation of Portland Oregon who made the highest and best bid therefor at said sale, for the sum of \$2.20 $\frac{19}{100}$ Dollars per acre and being in the aggregate the sum of Three Hundred Fifty-two and $\frac{17}{100}$ Dollars for the 160 acres of said real property situated in said County and State and described in said order as follows:
