This is to certify, that White Salmon Irrigation District of White Salmon, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulies of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Black Sand Creek, a tributary of Swampy Creek, with point or points of diversion within unsurveyed land in Skamania County, about 750 ft. Montherly from a point where modifican Trail crosses Black Sand Creek Sec. Twp. ____, Mange ___ W.
