

Together with the tenements, hereditaments, and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any wise appertaining; and also the estate right title and interest of the said part of the first part, of, in and to the same, to have and to hold the hereinbefore granted, bargained and described premises, with the appurtenances unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
