That said Mortgagors for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and Fifty Dollars to him in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, alienated, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, alienate, release, convey and confirm unto the said mortgagor, his heirs and assigns forever, all the following described real estate, situated in the County of Stevens and State of Washington, to wit: All the land and improvements in the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section Thirty Six (36) Township Three 1/2 North of Range Seven 1/2 East of Willamette Meridian, the same being all of the Northwest quarter of the Southwest quarter of said Section 36 that lies south of a point twenty feet south of the south bank of Rock Creek.
