Black, Mortgagee, Witnesseth, That said Mortgagors for and in consideration of the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars, to them in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, have bargained, sold, aliened, released, conveyed and confirmed, and by these presents do bargain, sell, alien, release, convey and confirm unto the said mortgagor, his heirs, and assigns forever, all the following described real estate, situated in the County of Skamania and State of Washington, to-wit: The fractional West half of the Southwest quarter and the Southeast quarter of the Southwest quarter of Section thirty-one in Township two North of Range five East of the Willamette Meridian in the State of Washington, containing one hundred and twenty acres and nine hundredth of an acre and being the same real estate as described and recorded in Book "B" of Deeds at page 52 thereof of the Records of Deeds in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County of the State of Washington, Together with the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining.
