The West half of the South East Quarter, of Section Ten, and the North East Quarter of the North West Quarter and the North West Quarter of North East Quarter of Section Fifteen in Township Four North of Range Seven East of the Willamette Meridian, containing One Hundred and Sixty Acres.

Together with all and singular the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and all of our right, title, interest, claim, possession or demand, of any kind whatever, whether at law or equity, of, in or to the above described premises, and each and every part and parcel thereof.

To Have and To Hold the same unto the - the said Storey Keeler Lumber Company and to its heirs and assigns forever, and we do hereby covenant with the said grantee, its heirs and assigns, that at the date hereof we were well seized in fee simple of the premises above conveyed, and we will and our heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the title thereto against the lawful claims or demands of any person or persons whomsoever.
