

H. M. Broadbent to Henry W. Coe

Know All Men By These Presents, that I, H. M. Broadbent of Lewis County, State of Washington in consideration of the sum of One Dollar (\$1.) to me paid by Henry W. Coe of Portland Multnomah County, State of Oregon, do hereby remise, release and forever quit Claim unto the said Henry W. Coe, all my right title and interest in and to the Norway Discovery Claim in St. Helens Mining District Skamania County State of Washington, which said mining claim is situated on the south slope of the Spirit Lake Range about one half mile westerly from Spirit Lake and about five miles northerly from Mt. St. Helens. Said claim is located along and on Lake Canyon Creek. The northeasterly corner of said claim is about one hundred and fifty feet southwesterly from the Norway Cabin, and is distinctly marked on the ground so that its boundaries may be readily traced as follows:—

Commencing at the point of discovery which is an open cut about fifty feet long ending in a tunnel about twenty-eight feet long and running thence in a northwesterly direction one hundred and fifty feet to a large cedar tree blazed on one side, which tree marks the beginning of the boundaries of said claim and is situated in the middle of the northwest end line thereof: thence three hundred feet in a northeasterly direction to a cedar tree blazed on three sides which tree marks the most northerly corner of said claim; thence seven hundred and fifty feet in a southeasterly direction to a cedar tree blazed on four sides which marks the middle of the northeasterly side line of said claim, thence continuing on the same southeasterly course, seven hundred and fifty feet to a white fir tree blazed on four sides which marks the most easterly corner of said claim, thence in a southwesterly direction six hundred feet to a white fir tree blazed on four sides which marks the most southerly corner of said claim thence seven hundred and fifty feet in a northwesterly direction to a larch tree blazed on four sides which marks the center of the southwesterly side line of said claim, thence seven hundred and fifty feet in the same northwesterly
