

Discovery Claims Nos 1 and 2, said White Jacket Lode being the first lode staked below the Portland Lode claims parallel thereto; from said discovery stake on this claim run fifteen hundred linear feet in a southeasterly direction, and three hundred linear feet in width on each side of the center line of the lode.

3. The South-East Extension Claim No 1 of the Hamilton Lode, in the said Mining District, said Okanama or Lewis County, beginning at discovery, situated on the south slope of Goat Mountain in range 5 east of Willamette Meridian on unsurveyed land so near the line between the said counties it is not known definitely in which of the said counties the claim is situated; the discovery is marked by a stake and is 1500 in a southeasterly direction from the stake at discovery on the line between claims Nos. 1 and 2 of the same lode, which last mentioned stake is near the bank of the creek which is the outlet of Dead Man's Lake on said mountain about 2300 feet below the outlet of said lake into said stream; from said beginning stake of this claim as above described this claim runs fifteen hundred linear feet in a southeast direction and three hundred feet in width on each side of the center line of the lode or vein. This claim is parallel to the South East Extension claim No 1 of the White Jacket Lode which it adjoins above, and the South East Extension Claim No 1 of the Portland next above the White Jacket.

The South East Extension Claim No 1 of the Alexander Lode, in said Mining District, said Okanama or Lewis County, Washington in range 5 east of the Willamette Meridian, so close to the county line between said counties it is not definitely known in which county it is situated; the beginning of the claim is on the south slope of Goat Mountain at discovery 1500 feet in a southeasterly direction from the stake on the line between claims Nos. 1 and 2 of Discovery claims of this lode, said last mentioned stake is set on the bank of the creek which is the outlet of Dead Man's lake on said mountain about 2900 feet below the outlet of Dead Man's Lake or said mountain about 2900 feet below the outlet of said lake into the said creek; from the said beginning point of this claim aforesaid the claim runs 1500 linear feet in a south-
