

W. A. Gray to the Goat Mountain Mining & T. & C.

The grantor, W. A. Gray of County Lewis County, Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred Dollars in hand paid hereby bargains, sells and conveys to the Goat Mountain Mining and Tunneling Company, a corporation the following named and described mining claim locations, all of which are situated in the St. Helens Mining District in the County of Skamania or Lewis, State of Washington, so near the line between the said Counties it is not known definitely in which Counties they are situated, and in range 5 east of the Willamette Meridian, on the south slope of Goat Mountain. Said claims are described as follows:

First. Portland Lode, Discovery Claim No. 2. Beginning at discovery, on unsurveyed land at a small dead fir tree a few feet east of the creek which is the outlet of Dead Man's Lake on said mountain at a point about 1100 feet southwesterly from the beginning of the outlet of said lake into said creek, which stake is the common beginning point of this claim and of Discovery Claim No. 1 of same lode, thence running in a north westerly direction fifteen hundred linear feet, and three hundred feet in width on each side of the center line of the lode.

Second. White Jacket Lode, Discovery Claim No. 1. Beginning at discovery on unsurveyed land at a stake on the bank of the creek which is the outlet of Dead Man's Lake on said mountain about 1700 feet below the outlet of said lake into said creek, and is the next lode staked below the Portland Lode claims on said creek, from discovery stake, running thence in a northwesterly direction fifteen hundred linear feet and three hundred feet in width on each side of the center line of said lode.

Third. Hamilton Lode, Discovery Claim No. 1. Beginning at discovery on unsurveyed land at a stake set at discovery which is near the bank of the creek which is the outlet of Dead Man's Lake on said mountain about 2300 feet below the outlet of said lake into said creek, and is the common corner of this claim and claim No. 1 of same lode, from said stake the claim runs fifteen hundred linear feet in a north westerly direction parallel to the White Jacket lode on the north or northeast, and the Portland Lode which is above the White Jacket, and three hundred feet in width on each
