BE ITORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF STEVENSON.

Sec. 1. There is hereby granted to McKeighan & Wachter Company, a comparation, A FRANCHISE TO CONSTRUCT, LAY AND MAINTAIN ACROSS SECOND STREET OF THE TOWN OF STEVENSON CONDUIT OR CONDUITS BETWEEN LOTS | AND 2 OF BLOCK 9 AND LOTS 29 AND 30 AND 31 of Block 6 of the original Town of Stevenson, for the purpose of conveying therein AND THERETHROUGH WATER, GASOLINE, ELECTRIC WIRING, GAS, STEAM AND HEAT, ALSO TO CONSTRUCT, OPERATE AND MAINTAIN UPON SECOND STREET TWO GASOLINE AND OIL FILLING PUMPS. Two water faucets or hydrants and Two air filling pumps, the same to be placed as FOLLOWS:
