

J. M. Gray to Goat Mountain Mtn & T. & C.

The Grantor, J. M. Gray, unmarried of Cowlitz, Lewis County, Washington, for and in consideration of the sum of Five hundred Dollars in hand paid, hereby bargains, sells, and conveys to the Goat Mountain Mining and Tunnel Site Company, a corporation the following described real estate to wit, the following described mining claim locations, situated in the St. Helens Mining District, in the county of Skamania or Lewis, Washington, on the south slope of Goat Mountain on range 5 east of the Willamette Meridian on unsurveyed land so near the county line between the said counties it is not known definitely in which county said claim is located. First claim is the Portland Lode Discovery Claim No 1, and begins at discovery as follows:

Beginning at a small dead fir tree a few feet east of the creek which is the outlet of Dead Man's Lake on said mountain at a point about 1100 feet in a southwesterly direction from the beginning of the outlet of said Lake into said creek as near as can be estimated, thence running in a southeasterly direction fifteen hundred linear feet and three hundred feet in width on each side of the center line of the lode.

The second claim is situated on the said mountain, and range and in either one or the other of said counties, but just which it is not known as aforesaid, and is known as the White Jacket Lode, North-West Extension Claim No 1, beginning at discovery which is at a stake fifteen hundred feet in a north westerly direction from a certain stake ~~fifteen hundred feet in~~ on the bank of the creek which is the outlet of Dead Man's Lake on said mountain about 1700 feet below the outlet of said lake into said creek, and is the common corner at discovery on the lead between the White Jacket Lode Discovery Claims Nos 1 and 2, said lode being the first lode staked below the Portland Lode claims; from discovery stake to this claim run fifteen hundred linear feet in a northwesterly direction and three hundred feet in width on each side of the center line of said lode.

The third claim hereby conveyed is situated on the said mountain, same range as aforesaid, and in the said Mining District in one of said counties, but
