

Ella V. Brown to F. W. Leadbetter.

This Indenture, made this 2nd day of October, A.D. 1901, between Ella V. Brown, of Skagway, Washington, wife of James Brown, with whom Carrie M. Corey and Jasper H. Corey entered into an agreement for the sale of timber on the land after described lands, and for right-of-way over same, party of the first part, and F. W. Leadbetter, of Clark County, Washington, party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other good and valuable considerations, to me in hand paid by the said party of the second part, do by these presents, remise, release, convey and quitclaim, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, all interest of the party of the first part in the following described real estate, lying and being in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to-wit:

Lots numbered Six and Seven and the East half of the South West quarter of Section Six, in Township Two North of Range Five East of Willamette Meridian, containing 169. 95 acres.

To have and to hold, unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, forever, all the interest of the party of the first part in the above described premises with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging.
