Interest to be paid annually, and if not so paid, the whole sum of both Principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible, at the option of the holder of this note. And in case suit or action be instituted to collect this note or any portion thereof we promise to pay in addition to the costs and disbursements provided by statute, such additional sum in like Gold Coin as the Court may adjudge reasonable for attorneys fees to be allowed and paid in suit or action.
