Know all men by these Presents, That we Rupert Blue and Juliette Blue his wife, now of the city and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, in consideration of the sum of one dollar to us in hand paid by Henry W. Coe of Portland, Multnomah County, State of Oregon, do hereby remise release and forever quitclaim unto the said Henry W. Coe and unto his heirs and assigns all their right, title and interest in and to the following described parcel of real estate, situate in St. Helens District, County of Skamania State of Washington, to-wit:

an undivided one sixteenth interest in

Fifteen Hundred (1500) linear feet on the Chicago Lode situated in the St. Helens Mining District, State of Washington and described as follows: Beginning at the terminus of the Chicago Discovery Claim and running fifteen hundred (1500) linear feet in a North Westerly direction and three hundred (300) feet on each side of center of vein. This claim is situated fifteen hundred (1500) feet North Westerly of and adjoining the original discovery of claim, near the head of the North Fork River.
