

Ole Thompson to R. A. Brown

Two hundred and <sup>00</sup>/<sub>100</sub> Dollars with interest from date at the rate of eight per cent per annum, interest payable semiannually, and if not so paid, the whole sum of both principal and interest to become immediately due and collectible, at the option of the holder of this note. If not so collected, the interest to be added to and become part of the principal, and the same to bear interest thereafter, until paid at the rate of ten per cent per annum. Principal and interest payable in U. S. Gold coin. And in case action is commenced to enforce payment of this note, or any portion thereof, we promise to pay such additional sum as the court may adjudge reasonable as attorney's fees in said action.
