A. C. Hooper to H. H. McCarthy.

This Indenture, made the 9th day of July in the year of our Lord, nineteen hundred between A. C. Hooper of the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon party of the first; and H. H. McCarthy of the County of Multnomah and State of Oregon party of the second; Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to one in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged; has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quit-claimed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quit-claim unto the said H. H. McCarthy said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns The lode as located, surveyed, recorded and held by said party of the first part, situated in St. Helens Mining District Skamania County State of Washington and better known and described as follows:

Beginning about twenty five feet North west of Lake Canyon, where location notice is posted, and running fifteen hundred feet in a South-East direction and three hundred feet on each side of the center of said vein, the discovery is about one half mile from Spirit Lake, and about one half mile below the Norway Camp on Lake Canyon in St. Helens Mining District and duly recorded in Skamania County in the State of Washington, and known as the Sweeden Mine.
