In Consideration of Three thousand two hundred twenty-seven and $\frac{50}{100}$ (\$3227.50) Dollars, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the State of Washington does hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto S. Benson his heirs and assigns, the following described granted lands, selected and approved in part satisfaction of the grant for Public Buildings at the State Capital, under the seventeenth section of the Enabling Act, to-wit:
