Also a tract beginning at the 1/4 corner to sections 10 and 11 in Township three north of Range 10 East W.M. Running thence North $88^{\circ} 56'$ West 4.14 chains thence North $1^{\circ} 04'$ East 2.40^{1/2} chains, thence south $88^{\circ} 56'$ East 4.14 chains south $1^{\circ} 04'$ west 2.40^{1/2} chains to initial point of survey and containing one acre.
