Now Therefore, if the said promissory note, principal and interest and attorney's fees, shall be paid when the same shall become due, according to the terms and conditions of said promissory note and of this indenture, then this indenture shall be void, but in case default be made in the payment of the principal or interest mentioned in said promissory note or any part thereof, or in case default shall be made in the payment of any sum that may become due and payable, as hereinafter provided, then the party of the second part, her executors, administrators and assigns are hereby empowered to sell the premises above described, with all and every of the appurtenances or any part thereof, in the manner prescribed by law, and out of the money arising from said sale to retain the said principal and attorney's fees, and such other sum or sums as may be due hereunder, together with the costs and charges of making such sale, and the overplus, if any, pay or demand to the parties of the first part, their heirs or assigns. And the said parties of the first part, their heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant and agree to pay unto the said party of the second part, her executors, administrators or assigns, the said sum of money as above mentioned.
