This Indenture, made this 11th day of July, A.D. 1900 by and between Peter Sjolin, a single man, of Skamania County, Washington, party of the first part, and The Storey & Kaeppler Lumber Co. a corporation, of La Crosse County, Wisconsin, party of the second part, Witnesseth:

That for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred and Seventy-five Dollars to me in hand paid by the Storey and Kaeppler Lumber Co., the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I have this day bargained and sold, and do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto the said Storey and Kaeppler Lumber Co., all standing and down timber of every description whatsoever, on the following described lands, to-wit:

The South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 & South 1/2 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 36, in Township 4 North of Range 7 East T.T.M. containing 160 acres, in Skamania County, Washington, together with the right of ingress and egress over and through said lands for logging purposes.

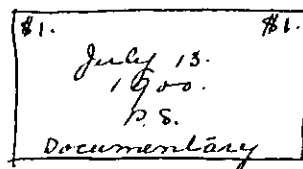
To Have and to hold unto the said Storey and Kaeppler Lumber Co., a corporation, its heirs and assigns forever; and the title to the foregoing described timber I bind myself and my heirs and legal representatives to forever warrant and defend unto the said Storey & Kaeppler Lumber Co., a corporation and to its assigns and legal representatives against the lawful claims of all persons claiming or to claim the same or any part thereof.

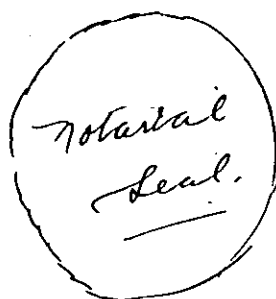
