O'Connor of Toledo, Lewis County, State of Washington, party of the second part, Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar lawful money of the United States of America, to me in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, conveyed and quit-claimed, and by these presents, does grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, convey and quit-claim unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever, all the right, title and interest, estate, claim and demands, of said party of the first part, of, in and to that certain portion, claim and mining right, title and property on the certain ledges, veins, lodes or deposits of quartz and other rock in place, containing precious metals of gold, silver and other metals, and situated in the St. Helens Mining District, County of Skamania, and State of Washington and described as follows, to wit:
