

the manner provided by law, and out of the money arising from such sale retain the said principal and interest, together with the costs and charges of making such sale and attorney's fee and the surplus, if any there be, pay over to the said L. P. McCroskey & Sons Lumber Co. its successors and assigns. In case of foreclosure of this mortgage a deficiency judgment may be taken at the option of the holder thereof.
