North half of North East quarter, Section Thirty-five, and South half of South East quarter of Section Twenty-six, in Township Four North, Range Seven East, Hellamette Meridian, together with right-of-way and ingress and egress over and through said land for logging purposes.

To Have and to Hold unto the said Storøy & Kaeppler Lumber Company its heirs and assigns forever; and the title to the foregoing described timber and every part thereof I bind myself and my heirs and legal representatives forever warrant and defend unto the said Storøy & Kaeppler Lumber Company and to its heirs, assigns and legal representatives against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.
