

W. W. + Mary O'Conner to Henry W. Coe.

This Indenture, made the 13th day of November in the year of our Lord, one thousand nine hundred and One (1901) between W. W. O'Conner, and Mary O'Conner his wife, of Toledo, Wash; parties of the first part, and Henry W. Coe of Portland, Oregon, party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One (1) Dollars, lawful money of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns...

That certain property known as the Samson (or Sampson) Group of Mining Quartz Claims in the St. Helens Mining District, State of Washington, said Mining District being located in Lewis and Clark and Clallam Counties, in said State; Said group is situated upon a spur of the Coast Mountain Range of mountains, is crossed by the Samson Creek, is about (10) ten miles North easterly from Mt. St. Helens, and consists of about four hundred (400) acres of ground.
