## COMMUNITY PROPERTY AGREEMENT

THIS AGREEMENT, made and entered into this 21st day of August, 1948, by and between CARL A. RAHN, and NELLE R. RAHN, husband and wife, residing in Skamania County, and State of Washington, WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS said Carl A. Rahn, and Nelle R. Rahn, are husband and wife, and are the owners of certain real property described as follows, to-wit:

Commencing at the SE corner of Lot 2, Block 16, Manzanola Tracts according to the official plat thereof on file and of record in the office of the Auditor of Skamania County, Washington, thence west 405 feet, thence north 100 feet, thence northeasterly to a point on the west line of said Lot 2 which is 312 feet north of the southeast corner thereof, thence east 245 feet more or less to the westerly line of the Jessup Road, thence southerly along the westerly line of said Jessup Road to the south line of Lot 1, said Block 16, thence west along the south line of said Lot 1 to the point of beginning.

and being desirous that said property shall pass without delay or expense to the survivor;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the love and affection that each of said parties has for the other, it is hereby agreed that in case of the death of said Carl A. Rahn while said Nelle R. Rahn survives, the whole of said property hereinabove described, together with any other property by them hereafter acquired, shall vest at once in said Nelle R. Rahn in fee simple, and in the event of the death of said Nelle R. Rahn leaving the said Carl A. Rahn surviving her, the whole of said property hereinbefore described, together with all property by them subsequently acquired, shall at once vest in the said Carl A. Rahn in fee simple.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, that JAMES J. ARCHER of Carson, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, with point or points of diversion within the S $\frac{1}{2}$  of NW $\frac{1}{4}$  Sec 14, Twp. 4 N., Range 7 E. W. M., for the purposes of domestic supply under Appropriation Permit No. 4669 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the Laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 7, at Page 3138, on the 17th day of September, 1948; that the right hereby confirmed dates from February 18, 1946; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 of a cubic foot per second

A description of the lands under such right to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
