CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

(In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amend-ments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics thereunder.)

This is to certify, that SKAMANIA COUNTY P.U.D. NO. 1 of Stevenson, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of unmamed springs, a tributary of Columbia wiver, with point or points of diversion within the 32 of NEt of NW. of Sec. 30, Twp. 3 N., Range 10 E. W.M., for the purposes of domestic supply and spraying under Appropriation Permit No. 4927 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 7, Page 3195, on the 7th day of December, 1948; that the right hereby confirmed dates from October 29, 1946; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said exceed purposes, and shall not / 0.33 of a cubic foot per second.
