Also to bargain and agree for, buy, sell, mortgage, hypothecate, and in any and every way and manner deal in and with goods, wares and merchandise, choses in action, and other property in possession or in action and to make, do and transact all and every kind of business of what nature and kind soever, and also, for me and in my name, and as my act and deed, to sign, endorse, seal, execute, deliver, and acknowledged such deeds, covenants, indentures, agreements, mortgages, hypothecation bills of lading, bills, bonds, war bonds, government checks, notes, receipts, evidences of debt, releases and satisfaction of mortgage, judgment and other debts and such other instruments in writing, of whatever kind and nature as may be necessary and proper in the premises.

Giving and granting unto my said attorney full power and authority to do and perform all and every act and thing whatsoever required and necessary to be done in and about the premises, as fully to all intents and purposes as I might or could do if personally present, and I hereby ratify and confirm that my said attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be done by virtue of these presents.

WAIVER OF DAMAGES

WHEREAS, during the betterment and construction work on the Panther Creek Road by the Columbia National Forest during 1947 and 1948, rocks, dirt and debris were deposited in said creek where it traverses land owned by us, the undersigned, in the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, SW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 25, T. 4 N., R. 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ E., W.M., and,

WHEREAS, such obstruction in the stream has caused or is likely to cause the water to back up and overflow some of said land, and,

WHEREAS, the back-up of such water and the formation of a pond will, in our opinion, benefit said land,

NOW, THEREFORE, we request the Columbia National Forest to leave said rocks, dirt and debris as they are or may be after further work, and not to remove or disturb them.

For ourselves, our heirs, successors and assigns we hereby waive all claims against the United States, its agents and employees, for damages that may result from any present or future action of Panther Creek water resulting from such obstruction.

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This is to certify, that UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, COLUMBIA NATIONAL FOREST, UNITED STATES FOREST SERVICE of Vancouver, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, with point or points of diversion within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 27, Twp. 7 N., Range 6 E., W.M., for the purposes of domestic supply, garden irrigation and fire protection under Appropriation Permit No. 3818 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, and entered of record in Volume 7, at page 3238, on the 21st day of February, 1949; that the right hereby confirmed dates from May 1, 1943; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.01 of a cubic foot per second.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water hereby confirmed is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:
