

This Indenture made this 21st day of November, 1901, by and between H. A. Gray, unmarried and H. B. Gray, unmarried, both of Clatsop County, Washington, E. A. Sessions and Kate D. Sessions his wife, G. W. Simpson and Carrie L. Simpson, his wife, E. A. Sessions and G. W. Simpson partners as Sessions and Simpson, Trustees, and G. C. Ames, unmarried, of Portland, Oregon, parties of the first part, and the Oregon and Washington Mining and Trust Company, an Oregon Corporation, party of the second part,

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty thousand dollars to them in hand paid, the receipt for which is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and forever quitclaimed and by these presents do convey unto the said party of the second part and unto its assigns forever all the following described Mining property situated in the St. Helens Mining District in the State of Washington and more particularly described as follows, to wit:-

Independence Lode No. 1, situated in Skamania County, in said district and State. The discovery point is in a gulch on the North slope of Center Peak Mountain, adjacent to which point is a blazed tree with the location notice written thereon and about 100 feet from the said discovery point on the left hand of the stream in said ravine in a direction from the discovery point West of North stands a large lone fir tree; said discovery is about 1600 feet South of the North Fork River and about 1/2 mile Southwest of the Minnie Lee Cabin and about that distance from the Minnie Lee group of claims. Said claim extends along said ledge or vein in a Southwest direction from the discovery 1500 linear feet and 300 feet in width on each side of the center line thereof. The center end lines and corners are marked with blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Independence Lode No. 2, situated in Skamania County, in said District and State, the claim begins at the Northeast end of Independence Lode No. 1 and at the discovery thereof which is in the gulch on the North slope of Center Peak Mountain adjacent to which point is a blazed tree with the location notice of this claim and of Independence Lode No. 1 written thereon, about 100 feet from said discovery on the left of said stream in said gulch, in a direction from said discovery West of North stands a large lone fir tree, and extending from said discovery point in a Northeast direction along the center line of said vein 1500 feet in length and 300 feet in width on each side of the center line thereof, claim is about 1600 feet South of the North Fork River and about 1/2 mile South of the Minnie Lee group of mines, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.
