

the same distance from the Minnie Lee Cabin and group of claims, commencing at a point about 600 feet South of the discovery of Independence Lode Nos. 3 & 4, reference to the location notices of which is hereby made, said discovery being adjacent to a tree with the location notices of this claim and of Black Bird No. 1 written thereon and also witness a white fir tree about 50 feet East of said discovery in a Northeast direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners written thereon. Claim adjoins Independence Lode No. 4 on the South.

Also, The Red Bird Lode No. 1, situated in said Steamboat County and on the North slope of Center Peak Mountain and about one mile South of the North Snake River and about the same distance South of the Minnie Lee Cabin and group of mines and commencing at a point about 1200 feet South of the discovery point of Independence Lode Nos. 3 & 4, reference to the location notices of which is hereby made, adjacent to the discovery is a tree with the location notice written thereon and also witness a Sarch tree about 75 feet Southeast of the discovery about one and one half feet in diameter, extending from said discovery point along the center of the lode in a southwest direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Red Bird Lode No. 2, situated in said Steamboat County on the North slope of Center Peak Mountain and about one mile South of the North Snake River and about the same distance South of the Minnie Lee Cabin and group of claims and adjoining the Black Bird Lode No. 2 on the South and commencing at a point about 1200 feet South of the discovery point of Independence Lode Nos. 3 & 4, reference to the location notices of which is hereby made, adjacent to the discovery is a tree with the location notices of this claim and of Black Bird Lode No. 1 written thereon and also witness a Sarch tree about 75 feet Southeast of the discovery about one and one half feet in diameter, extending from said discovery in a Northeast direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Columbia Lode No. 1 situated in said Steamboat County and on Falls Creek about three miles below the Falls thereon and on the North slope of Venus Mountain and about one and one half miles South of the North Snake River and about two miles South
