Also, The Mary Ann Lode No. 1, situated in said Skamania County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and North of the North Toutle River and about three thousand feet Northwest of the Polar Star mine, beginning at the discovery which is about twenty feet Southwest of a small Fir tree on which is posted the location notice, extending from said discovery in a North-east direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners written thereon.

Also, The Mary Ann Lode No. 2, situated in said Skamania County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and North of the North Toutle River and about three thousand feet Northwest of the Polar Star mine, beginning at the discovery of Mary Ann Lode No. 1 which is about twenty feet Southwest of a small Fir tree on which is written the location notice of this claim and of said Mary Ann Lode No. 1, and running from thence and from the Southwest end line of said Mary Ann Lode No. 1 in a Southwest direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners being marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Last Chance Lode No. 1, situated in said Skamania County, and on the South slope of Goat Mountain, beginning at the discovery post which is about one mile West of Black Falls on the North Toutle River and on the North side thereof and about one and one fourth mile West of the tunnel of the Polar Star mine, said discovery post having the location notice posted thereon, also witness a big Fir tree Southeast of said post about three feet in diameter, extending from said discovery in a Northeast direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Last Chance Lode No. 2, situated in said Skamania County and on the slope of Goat Mountain, beginning at the discovery thereof and of Last Chance Lode No. 1, which is about one $\frac{1}{2}$ mile North West of Black Falls on the North Toutle River and about one and one fourth mile west of the Polar Star tunnel, the location post is adjacent to the discovery and has the location notice of this claim and of the Last Chance Lode No. 1 written thereon, witness a big fir tree about three feet in diameter Southeast of said post, extending Southwest from said discovery post
