

Northeast center end line of Viola Lode No. 1, and extending thence in a North East direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Viola Lode No. 1, Southwest, situated in said Skamania County, and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and North of the North Fork of the Toutle River and in the third gulch West of the Polar Star mine and about forty five hundred feet therefrom, beginning at a dead Cedar post standing in said gulch with the location notice of this claim and of Viola Lode No. 1 written thereon, and being about fifty feet South of a large Fir tree lying across said gulch, extending from thence in a Southwestern direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners written thereon.

Also, The Viola Lode No. 2, Southwest, situated in said Skamania County, and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and North of the North Toutle River and beginning at the Southwest center end line of Viola Lode No. 1, Southwest, which is 1500 feet Southwest of the discovery of Viola Lode No. 1, which said discovery is in the third gulch west of the Polar Star mine and about 4500 feet distant therefrom and extending from said Southwest center end of said Viola Lode No. 1 Southwest in a Southwestern direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Black Horn Lode No. 1, situated in said Skamania County and on the North slope of Venus Mountain and on Falls Creek and about two miles South of the North Toutle River and about two and one half miles in a Southerly direction from the Minnie Lee claim, there is a tree adjacent to the discovery with the location notice written thereon and about thirty feet West of the discovery stands a large Fir tree about four feet in diameter extending from said discovery in a Northeast direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Black Horn Lode No. 2, situated in the said Skamania County, and on the North slope of Venus Mountain and on Falls Creek and about two miles South of the North Toutle River and two and one half miles in a Southerly direction from the
