

Minnie Lee claim, beginning at the discovery of Black Horn Lode No. 1 where there is a tree with the location of this claim and of said Black Horn No. 1 written thereon, and about fifty feet West of said point is a large fir tree about four feet in diameter extending from said discovery in a Southwestern direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners being marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Cracker Jack Lode No. 1, situated in Lewis County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and North of North Tautle River and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile distant therefrom, beginning at the discovery post which is adjacent to the discovery and on which is written the location notice, there is a small cedar tree about twenty feet South of the discovery with two sides blazed, which is about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile West of the discovery post of the Minnie Lee claim and is adjacent to and North of the Tugget claim, extending from said discovery in a Northwest direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Cracker Jack Lode No. 1 Southeast, situated in Lewis County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile North of the North Tautle River and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile West of the Minnie Lee claim, beginning at the discovery of this claim and of Cracker Jack Lode No. 1 which it abuts on the South East, adjacent to the discovery is a post on which is written this location notice and that of Cracker Jack No. 1, there is a small cedar tree about twenty feet South of the discovery two sides of which are blazed, extending from said discovery in a Southeast direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees the respective center end lines and corners of which are marked thereon.

Also, The Cracker Jack Lode No. 2 Southeast, situated in Lewis County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile North of the North Tautle River, and about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile west of the discovery post of the Minnie Lee claim, beginning at the discovery post of Cracker Jack Lode No. 1 which is on the South slope of Goat Mountain and North of North Tautle River and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile distant therefrom and about the same distance West of the discovery post of the Minnie Lee claim, and which is adjacent to the last mentioned discovery and on which is written the location notice of Cracker Jack Lode No. 1 and of Cracker Jack Lode No. 1 Southeast, witness a small cedar tree about 20 feet South of said discovery with two sides
