

F. R. Laveyport to J. M. Corper.

Know all men by these presents, That I, Frank R. Laveyport, the party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand (1000.00) Dollars lawful money of the United States of America, to me in hand paid by J. M. Corper, the party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold, assigned transferred and set over and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assign, transfer and set over unto the said party of the second part, a certain Indenture of Mortgage, bearing date the 16th day of September A.D. 1907, made and executed by Geo. A. Pleydison, a single man, to the said party of the first part, to secure the payment of the sum of One thousand Dollars, together with the note or obligation therein described, and the money due, or to grow due thereon with the interest; which said Indenture of Mortgage will be recorded in the office of the Auditor of the County of Skamania, State of Washington in book 5 of Mortgages, page 579 on the 8th day of Oct. And the said party of the first part does hereby covenant to and with the said party of the second part that he is the lawful owner and holder of the said note and Mortgage, and that I have good right to sell, transfer and assign the same as aforesaid and that there is now due and owing upon said note and Mortgage the sum of One thousand (1000.00) Dollars with interest from the 16th day of September 1907.
