

blazed, running thence Southeast along the center line of said Cracker Jack Lode No. 1, Southeast, to the Southeast center end line thereof for a commencing point, running thence in a Southeast direction along the center line of said lode 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners thereof are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Cracker Jack Lode No. 2 Northwest, situated on the North slope of Goat Mountain in Lewis County and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile North of the North South River and about the same distance West of the Minnie Lee group of claims, beginning at the Northwest center end line of Cracker Jack Lode No. 1, on which this claim abuts reference to the location notice of which is hereby made, extending from said center end line in a Northwest direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners of which are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Daisy May Lode No. 1, situated in Lewis County and on the South side of Goat Mountain and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile North of the North South River and about the same distance from the Minnie Lee Group of claims and beginning at a post adjacent to said discovery being a small dead Hemlock tree with the location notice written thereon and in a small gulch with a small stream of water flowing through it and about twenty feet North of a small waterfall and extending Northwest from said discovery 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Daisy May Lode No. 2, situated in Lewis County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile North of the North South River and about the same distance from the Minnie Lee group of claims and beginning at a post adjacent to said discovery being a small dead Hemlock tree with the location notice of this claim and of Daisy May Lode No. 1 written thereon and in a small gulch with a small stream of water flowing through it and about twenty feet North of a small waterfall, and claim abuts on the Southeast end of the Daisy May Lode No. 1 and extending from said beginning point in a Southeast direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked
