Also, The Nugget Lode No. 1, situated in Lewis County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile West of the Minnie Lee group of claims and $\frac{1}{2}$ a mile North of the North Tautle River, beginning at the discovery which is marked by a post adjacent thereto with the location notice written thereon, said discovery being in a gulch, witness a large Fir tree about fifty feet West thereof, extending Northwest from said discovery 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners written thereon.

Also, The Nugget Lode No. 2, situated in Lewis County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and $\frac{1}{2}$ mile North of the North Tautle River and $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile West of the Minnie Lee discovery post on which is the location notice of this claim and of the Nugget Lode No. 1, witness a large Fir tree about 30 feet West of the same, extending from said discovery in a Southeastern direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Black Diamond No. 1, situated in Lewis County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and North of North Tautle River and about one and one half mile west of the Minnie Lee claims and about one half mile north of the main trail leading into said district, beginning at the discovery adjacent to which is a Cedar tree about one and one half feet in diameter with the location notice posted thereon, witness a Fir tree about ten inches in diameter about fifty feet Southwest of the location notice, extending from said discovery in a Northwest direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Black Diamond Lode No. 2, situated in said Lewis County and on the South slope of Goat Mountain and North of the North Tautle River and about one half mile North of the main trail leading into said district and about one and one fourth mile West of the Minnie Lee cabin and group of claims beginning at a point 1500 feet Northwest of the discovery of Black Diamond Lode No. 1, which last discovery is witnessed by a Cedar tree about one and one half feet in diameter with the location notice of said Black Diamond Lode No. 1, written thereon and
