IN THE NAME OF GOD, AMEN, I Laurie J. Moody of the Town of Washougal in the County of Clark and State of Washington, being of lawful age, of sound and disposing mind and memory, and not acting under duress, menace or undue influence of any person whomsoever, do make, publish and declare this my Last Will and Testament, in the manner following, that is to say:

First, I hereby revoke all former wills made by me.

Second, I direct that my body be Buried in the Family Lot at Montesano, Wash.

Third, I direct that my executor, hereinafter named, as soon as He has sufficient funds, pay my funeral expenses and my just debts.

Fourth, I give and bequeath unto My Brothers, Harold Moody, and Leigh Moody of Seattle, Washington, and my Step Brother Frank H. Lawton of Spokane, Washington, each the sum of One Hundred (\$100.00) dollars.

Fifth, I give and bequeath to my Brother George Y. Moody of Washougal, Washington, all the rest, residue and remainder of the Estate of which I may Die possessed, both Real and Personal, where ever found and how ever situated.

Lastly, I hereby nominate, appoint and constitute George Y. Moody of Washougal, Washington, the Executor of this my Last Will and Testament, and it is my will, and I hereby direct that no bonds or security of any nature be required of my said Executor as such by any Court; and that no proceedings be had or taken in any Court in the settlement or administration of my estate, other than such as may be necessary for the proper proving and recording of this my Last Will and Testament, it being my intent and purpose to give, and I do hereby give unto said Executor full power and authority to settle my estate in the manner herein provided:
