

the location notice is posted on said cedar tree, extending from said discovery in a Northeast direction 1500 feet in length by 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners of said claim being marked by blazed trees with the respective end center lines and corners marked thereon;

Also, The First Chance Lode No. 2, situated on the South side of Goat Mountain and North of the North Tootle river and about 2000 feet North of Black Falls thereon and 2500 feet Northwest of the Polar Star mine, the discovery is in the second gulch below the Polar Star mine and about 20 feet North of a large dead cedar tree lying across said gulch with the location notice of this claim and of the First Chance No. 1 posted thereon, extending from said discovery and from the Southwest end line of the First Chance Lode No. 1 in a Southwest direction 1500 feet in length by 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective end center lines and corners marked thereon;

Also, The Norway Lode No. 1, situated on the North slope of Venus Mountain and about two miles South of the Minnie Lee claim the discovery is in Falls Creek and at the foot of the first falls thereon, about 20 feet West of the discovery stands a large White Fir Tree about 6 feet in diameter, beginning at the discovery the claim extends Northeast 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective end center lines and corners marked thereon;

Also, The Norway Lode No. 2, situated on the North slope of Venus Mountain and about two miles South of the Minnie Lee claim, the discovery is in Falls Creek and at the foot of the first falls thereon, about 20 feet West of the discovery stands a large White Fir Tree about six feet in diameter, beginning at the discovery and at the Southwest end line of the Norway Lode No. 1 and extending thence in a Southwest direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective end center lines and corners marked thereon;

Also, The Big Edd Lode No. 1, situated on the South slope of Goat Mountain and about one mile North of the North Tootle River and about 4000 feet West of the Polar Star mine, beginning at the discovery which is in the 3d. gulch West of the Polar Star mine and North of a small green cedar tree and about 30 feet distant from the same on which is the location notice, and extending from said discovery in a Northeast direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines marked thereon.
