

Also, The Big Edd Lode No. 2, situated on the South slope of Goat Mountain and about one mile North of the North Fork River and about 4000 feet West of the Polar Star Mine, beginning at the discovery which is in the 3d gulch West of the Polar Star Mine and about 30 feet North of a small green cedar tree on which is the location notice of the Big Edd Lode No. 1 and of this claim, and extending from said discovery in a Southwest direction and from the Southwest end line of the Big Edd Lode No. 1 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also, The Last Chance No. 1 Lode, situated on the South slope of Goat Mountain, beginning at the discovery post which is about one mile west of Black Falls on the North Fork River and about $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles west of the tunnel to the Polar Star mine, said discovery post having the location notice posted thereon, also witness a big fir tree Southeast of said post about three feet in diameter, extending from said discovery post in a Northeast direction 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon;

Also, The Last Chance No. 2 Lode, situated on the South slope of Goat Mountain, beginning at the discovery and at the discovery post of Last Chance No. 1 Lode, which post is about one mile West of Black Falls on the North Fork River and about $1\frac{1}{4}$ miles West of the tunnel of the Polar Star mine, said location post having the location notice written thereon, witness a big fir tree southeast of said post about three feet in diameter, extending Southwest from said discovery post and from the Southwest end line of the Last Chance Lode No. 1 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked there.

Also, The Yellow Crown Lode No. 1, situated on the North slope of Venus Mountain and about three miles South of the Minnie Lee claim and on Falls Creek and at the foot of the second falls thereon and of a large bluff, there is a large fir tree about 5 feet in diameter about 150 feet Northwest of the discovery, the location notice is posted adjacent to the discovery, extending Northeast of the discovery 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon;

Also, The Yellow Crown No. 2 Lode, situated on the North slope of Venus Mountain and about three miles South of the Minnie Lee
