

claim and on Falls Creek and at the foot of the second falls thereon and of a large bluff, there is a large Fir tree Northwest of the discovery about five feet in diameter and distant about 150 feet therefrom, extending Southwest of the discovery, 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the location notice is posted adjacent to the discovery, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners marked thereon.

Also; The Black Horn Lode No. 1, situated on the North slope of Venus mountain and on Falls Creek about two miles South of the North Tule River and about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles in a Southern direction from the Invernie See Claim, there is a tree at the discovery with the location notice written thereon and about thirty feet West of the discovery is a large Fir tree about four feet in diameter, extending Northeast of the discovery 1500 feet in length and 600 feet in width, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees with the respective center end lines and corners written thereon.

Also; The Black Horn Lode No. 2, situated on the North slope of Venus mountain and on Falls Creek about two miles South of the North Tule River and about $2\frac{1}{2}$ miles in a Southerly direction from the Invernie See claim, beginning at the discovery of Black Horn Lode No. 1 where there is a tree with the location notice of said claim and of this claim written thereon. And about 50 feet west of said point is a large Fir tree about 4 feet in diameter.

Extending Southwest of said discovery 1500 feet in length & 600 feet wide, the center end lines and corners are marked by blazed trees.

Together with all dips, opers and angles and all the metals and ores therein and all the rights and franchises incident and appurtenant thereto and all the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereunto belonging or appertaining.

To Have And To Hold, all and singular the premises aforesaid unto the said parties of the second part, their successors and assigns forever.
