This Indenture, made the twentieth day of December in the year of our Lord, one thousand, nine hundred and one between John D. Kileox of Portland, Oregon party of the first part, and Donald Mac Master of Vancouver B.C. party of the second part, Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty (\$50.⁰⁰) Dollars, Gold Coin of the United States of America, to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, remised, released and forever quitclaimed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, remise, release and forever quitclaim unto the said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns an undivided two fifths interest in and to the Blue Jacket lode claim, lying and being in the Bald Mountain Mining District, Skamania County, Washington, and described as follows: Beginning at discovery point where location notice is posted on Blue Jacket Creek, a South tributary of Blue Bird Creek, in Sec. 15. - Tp. 3 N. R. 5 E. W. 11. and running thence three hundred feet in a northeasterly direction to northeast corner post; thence southeasterly fifteen hundred feet to Southeast corner post; thence Southwesterly three hundred feet to South centre end post; thence three hundred feet South westerly to south west corner post; thence northwesterly course fifteen hundred feet to northwest corner post, thence three hundred feet northeasterly to place of beginning, as located June 13th, 1895, by D. C. Greenwalt.

Together with all the dips, apurs and angles, and also all the metals, ores, gold and silverbearing quartz, rock and earth therein; and all the right, privileges and franchises thereto incident, appendant and appurtenant, or therewith usually had and enjoyed; and also, all and singular, the tenements, hereditaments and appurtenances thereto belonging or in anywise appertaining, and the rents, issues and profit thereof; and also all the estate, right, title, interest, property possession, claim and demand whatsoever, as well in law as in equity, of the said party of the first part, of, in or to the said premises, and every part and parcel thereof, with the appurtenances.

To Have And To Hold, all and singular, the said premises, together with the appurtenances and privileges thereto incident, unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns forever.
