Martin never bought any stock and her deceased husband, Harry L. Martin, never bought any stock or shares of stock in Defiance Lumber Company. That all of the shares of stock owned by Gladys D. Martin at the time of the dissolution of said corporation were shares of stock dividends on shares of stock that had been given to her by her father, and all of said shares of stock were her separate property and no part thereof was community property.

That in connection with the dissolution of Defiance Lumber Company, Lee L. Doud and Donald H. Doud were appointed liquidating trustees of said Company, and on April 15, 1949, they executed as such liquidating trustees Special Warranty Deeds to all of the shareholders of Defiance Lumber Company, covering all real estate owned by said Company in the Counties hereinafter named, and included in said Deeds were Deeds conveying to Gladys D. Martin an undivided 332/2750ths interest in and to all real estate owned by said corporation, all of which Deeds were dated and acknowledged April 15, 1949. That said Deeds to Gladys D. Martin were thereafter recorded in the Auditor's Office in the following Counties on the following dates under the following respective fee or filing numbers:
