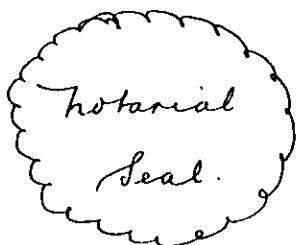

Olof Skolin & Wife to Storey & Keeler Lumber Co.

The Grantors, Olof Skolin and Caroline Skolin his wife of the County of Skamania and State of Washington. For and in consideration of Seven hundred and seventy five dollars (\$775.00) in hand paid, convey and warrant to Storey & Keeler Lumber Co. a corporation of the State of Wisconsin, the following-described timber or real estate, situated in the County of Skamania, State of Washington, to wit: All the standing and down timber of whatever nature now being on the South half of North East quarter and North half of the South East quarter of Section thirty five (35) in Township No 4 North of Range Seven (7) East of H. M. Together with the right of way for roads and camping purposes, and for building dams on creek for the purpose of removing the timber from said lands, except on any lands now improved. And it is expressly understood by and between the grantor and grantee that the said grantee shall have ten years from the eighth day of October 1901 in which to remove the aforementioned timber. And the said grantor further agrees to use all reasonable diligence to keep fires out of said timber.
