RAINEY of Wishram, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed spring, a tributary of Collin Creek, with point or points of diversion within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 27, Twp. 3 N., R. 8 E. W. This is to certify that UNDERWOOD FRUIT and WAREHOUSE COMPANY of Underwood, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Columbia River, with point or points of diversion within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, Twp. 3 N., R. 10 E., W. M., under Appropriation Permit No. 6671 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 8, at Page 3813, on the 14th day of October, 1950; that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is August 24, 1949 (see Note below), that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.33 of a cubic foot per second for the purposes of ice manufacturing, domestic supply, fruit washing, & cold storage.
