CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT

This is to certify that UNDERWOOD FRUIT and WAREHOUSE COMPANY of Underwood, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Columbia River, with point or points of diversion within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 22, Twp. 3 N., R. 10 E., W. M., under Appropriation Permit No. 6671 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 8, at Page 3813, on the 14th day of October, 1950; that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is August 24, 1949 (see Note below), that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.33 of a cubic foot per second for the purposes of ice manufacturing, domestic supply, fruit washing, & cold storage.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Being within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 23, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 10 E.W.M.

Note: This certificate has priority over Application No. 8897, (United States Fish & Wildlife Service) in accordance with stipulation and judgment entered in the District Court of the United States for the Western District of Washington, Southern Division, in Civil Case No. 1298, United States of America v. Underwood Fruit and Warehouse Company, et al .

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use hereindescribed, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
