This is to certify that PORTLAND LOCAL COUNCIL GIRL SCOUTS INCORPORATED of Portland, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of Collins Creek, a tributary of Columbia River, with point or points of diversion within the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, Twp. 3 N., R. 8 E. W. M., under Appropriation Permit No. 6279 issued by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Hydraulics of Washington and entered of record in Volume 8, at Page 3853, on the 4th day of November, 1950; that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is October 2, 1948; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.10 of a cubic foot per second for purpose of domestic supply for camp.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

All of Sec. 24, EXCEPT the NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and S $\frac{1}{2}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NW $\frac{1}{4}$ and NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 24, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E.W.M.

NE $\frac{1}{4}$, the SE $\frac{1}{4}$, and all of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E.W.M. SAVE AND EXCEPT from the SW $\frac{1}{4}$, "9 1/16 acres in the Northwest corner of said quarter section; particularly described as follows: being 50 rods South; thence 29 rods East; thence 50 rods North; thence 29 rods West to said corner post, also except 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres more or less, on the South side of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 25, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E.W.M., same being continued to the South side of Rock Creek and Collins County Road, and meandering line thereof as now established and of record, particularly described as follows, to wit:

Rge. 8 E.W.M., running thence West on the line, 80 rods; thence North 20 rods, to a stake on the South side of said Rock Creek and Collins County Road; thence 690 feet in a northeasterly direction on South line of said road, and conforming to meander line thereof, to a stake; thence 450 feet in a Southeasterly direction, on South side of said County Road; and conforming to meander line thereof to a stake, which stake is 330 feet North; and 180 feet West of the quarter corner of Sec. line between Sec. 25 and 36, Twp. 3 N. Rge. 8 E.W.M.; thence East 40 feet across said County Road, to a stake on the North side of said County Road, which said stake is 330 feet North; and 140 feet West of the quarter corner on Section line between Secs. 25 and 36, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E. W. EXCEPT from the above parcels of land a strip of land 300 feet in width acquired by the United States of America for Bonneville Transmission line and subject to easement conveyed to United States of America for access road to said Bonneville Transmission line. Also subject to easement for public road and highway over and across the said real property.

The right to the use of the water aforesaid hereby confirmed is restricted to the lands or place of use herein described, except as provided in Sections 6 and 7, Chapter 122, Laws of 1929.
