CERTIFICATE OF SURFACE WATER RIGHT (In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 117, Laws of Washington for 1917, and amendments thereto, and the rules and regulations of the State Supervisor of Water Resources thereunder.)

This is to certify that MAE S. WEDRICK of Home Valley, State of Washington, has made proof to the satisfaction of the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Columbia River; with point or points of diversion within the NE¼ of SE¼ of Sec. 27, Twp. 3 N., R. 8 E., W. M., under and subject to provisions contained in Appropriation Permit No. 5660 issued by the State Supervisor of Water Resources, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Washington, and is hereby confirmed by the State Supervisor of Water Resources of Washington and entered in Volume 9, at Page 4125, on the 31st day of July, 1951 that the priority date of the right hereby confirmed is July 12, 1947; that the amount of water under the right hereby confirmed, for the following purposes is limited to an amount actually beneficially used and shall not exceed 0.03 of a cubic foot per second for domestic supply and irrigation of 2 acres.

A description of the lands under such right to which the water right is appurtenant, and the place where such water is put to beneficial use, is as follows:

Commencing at a point 10 chains East; thence North 682 feet and 418 feet East of the intersection of the West boundary of Jos. Robbins D.L.S. with the South boundary of Sec. 27, Twp. 3 N., Rge. 8 E.W.M., being the point of beginning; thence North 209 feet; thence West 154 feet; thence North 429 ft.; thence East 396 ft.; thence South 638 ft. and thence West 242 feet to the point of beginning.
